6. Journal

Journaling is a popular educational tool to encourage students' self-reflection in the learning process.

The tutor opens an individual Journal for you, where you can present your individual reflections e.g. clinical case, or to get your opinion on certain problem. The Journal can be seen by you and your tutor only. After logging into the system on your page you can see the activity assigned for you individually. After you fill in your Journal with clinical case), it could be

assessed by an expert or tutor. Only the experts and tutors have the ability to assign a grade (there is no peer review). You are allowed to make a new version after corrections made by the tutor.
