The on-line module on Social medicine is designed to provide the basics on the topics within the programme of the internship.

The subject field of social medicine is complex and dynamic. The on-line module does not aim to be exhaustive but rather to provide you with the key concepts and to develop your skills of analysis of public health trends and formulation of priorities in your individual physician's work or public health authorities representative's work.
