SEMINAR 1

BASIC CONCEPTS OF ETHICS. CODES OF CONDUCT. PRINCIPLES OF ETHICS.

Objective of the seminar 1:

To enable the students to understand the ethical problems facing the medical profession today and to get acquainted with the codes of conduct and basic principles of medical ethics.

Enabling objectives:

At the end of the seminar the students should be able to:

- 1. Define the main areas of medical ethics.
- 2. Realize the increasing importance of medical ethics.
- 3. Determine ethical principles in ethical codes and their validity to contemporary medical practice.
- 4. Explain basic principles of medical ethics.

Syllabus of the seminar:

- 1. Medical ethics definition and importance for medical profession.
- 2. Ethical codes overview.
- 3. The hippocratic oath analysis; basic ethical principles and their validity for contemporary medical practice.
- 4. Declaration of Geneva. WMA International Code of Medical Ethics.
- 5. Basic principles of medical ethics: respect for autonomy, beneficence and nonmaleficence, justice.

Practical work:

- 1. Individual work on defining the common features in *the Hippocratic oath, declaration of Geneva and the international code of medical ethics.*
- 2. Discussion of case vignettes.
