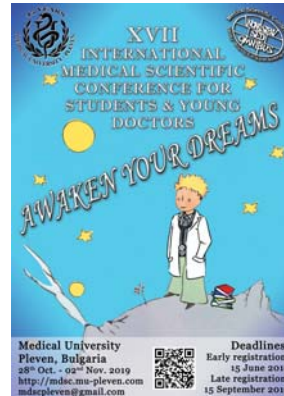

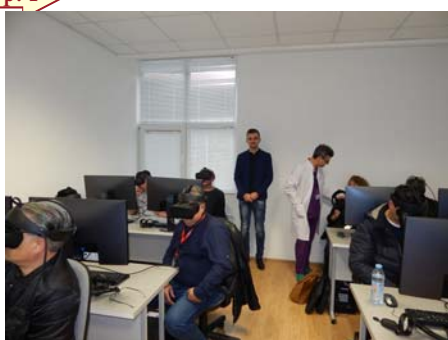

MU-PLEVEN CELEBRATED 45 YEARS SINCE ITS ESTABLISHMENT

The celebration of the 45th anniversary since the founding of MU - Pleven was marked by many events. The celebration began with a festive procession from the Rectorate building of MU-Pleven to Vazrazhdane Square. The academic leadership and the students of the university laid a wreath in front of the Eternal Flame of the Chapel-Mausoleum "St. George the Conqueror".

The celebration continued in Magnum Hall with a anniversary celebration and a concert by the Municipal Choir Gena Dimitrova. Part of the celebration was the ceremony of awarding the honorary title of Doctor Honoris Causa to Acad. Bogdan Petrunov, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of MU - Pleven for his outstanding contributions to the development of medical science in Bulgaria and the university. In his solemn speech, Acad. Petrunov expressed his gratitude for the prestigious award.

The Rector of the Medical University - Pleven, Prof. Dr. Slavcho Tomov addressed the students and guests of the celebration and shared the ambitions of the management: 'MU - Pleven has made serious investments in infrastructure, facilities, equipment; an outstanding base for the search of modern and innovative solutions, teaching and research.' He stressed that in order for the students to become good doctors and highly qualified specialists, they must first and foremost be good people and respect their patients.

Acad. Julian Rewalski, patron of the Scientific Conference dedicated to 45 years of MU - Pleven and 150 years of BAS, also gave a speech in front of the academic community.

The celebration ended with a concert by the Municipal Choir Gena Dimitrova.

Among the celebration events, dedicated to the 45th anniversary since the founding of the university, an official award ceremony was held for the representatives of the academic community, who in 2019 acquired new scientific degrees and were appointed to new academic positions. For the past



year, the number of those who successfully defended the educational-scientific degree "Doctor" was 12. Of those who were appointed to new academic positions, four are Senior Assistant Professors; four are Associate Professors and two are Professors. The Rector Prof. Dr. Slavcho Tomov awarded plaques



to the lecturers who achieved a new pinnacle in their academic development.

Medical University - Pleven is one of the five medical Universities in Bulgaria. It was established in 1974, expanding the horizons, size and reputation of the City Hospital, founded in 1865. Today, combining traditions of the past with the possibilities of the present, it incorporates educational and therapeutic facilities, contemporary pre-clinical base, University Hospitals with more than 1000 beds and clinics in all major medical fields, as well as a large number of specialized clinics and research units with modern diagnostic and therapeutic equipment. These are efficiently used to treat patients, train students, trainee physicians, postgraduates and for research work.

THE XVII INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE FOR STUDENTS AND YOUNG DOCTORS WAS HELD AT MU - PLEVEN

From October 28th to November 2nd, 2019 in the Telecommunication Endoscopy Center (TELEC) yet another emblematic for MU-Pleven conference was held - the XVII International Medical Scientific Conference for Students and Young Doctors (MDSC). This year's edition was part of the official scientific events dedicated to the 45th anniversary since the founding of Pleven's medical university. The conference this year was under the inspiring motto "Awaken your dreams".

The scientific forum was attended by 11 foreign lecturers from 7 countries (UK, Germany, Russia, Ukraine, Switzerland, USA and Japan) and 11 prominent Bulgarian scientists from 8 universities and research centers in the country. More than 300 active participants were registered with 120 reports, which were presented in 10 scientific sections in preclinical and clinical medical sciences and pharmacy, including 2 poster sessions. In addition, about 300 students and graduates from Bulgaria were registered to participate in different training modules and workshops.

For the fifth year in a row, the forum started with the established two-day Autumn School of Innovation in

Medicine. This fall, the focus of the school was on the latest diagnostic and therapeutic achievements in the field of gastroenterology and sexual health.

On October 28th (Monday), prominent Bulgarian lecturers and specialists from five of the leading university hospitals and centers participated in the Gastroenterology module, part of the Autumn School of Innovation in Medicine: Dr. Ivan Lyutakov, Ph.D. - UMHAT "Queen Joanna - ISUL", Sofia; Dr. Nikolai Stoyanov, MD - University Hospital "Pulmed", Plovdiv; Dr. Zornitsa Gorcheva - University Hospital "St. Marina", Pleven; Dr. Petko Karagiozov - Head of the Department of Invasive Gastroenterology, Acibadem City Clinic at Tokuda Hospital, Sofia and Dr. Alexander Katsarov - Department of Gastroenterology, Military Medical Academy, Sofia.

On October 29 (Tuesday), the Sexual Health module was moderated by the prominent Bulgarian psychiatrist, psychotherapist and sexologist, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Rumen Bostandjiev, MD. Lectures and clinical discussions were attended by local and international specialists in the field: Dr.

Nilani Nakiyran, Director of the training program for sexual and reproductive health at the St. George University, London, UK; Prof. Dr. Julia Naboka, MD, Head of the Department of Microbiology and Virology at the Rostov State Medical University in Russia and Dr. Manish Sachdeva from the Clinic of Urology at the University Hospital Dr. Georgi Stranski - Pleven.

The official opening ceremony of the conference was held on October 29th at 16:00 in the Ambrose Pare Hall, TELEC, with the anticipated participation of guest Lecturer, Prof. Dr. Michael Höckel, MD, Honorary Professor of Gynecology at the University of Leipzig and the Technical University of Munich, Germany, who focused his speech on the new aspects of the progression of malignant tumors.

The following scientific session, which has also become traditional for MU-Pleven, was the International Research Foundation Hasumi conference which was dedicated to the 45th anniversary since the founding of the university and the 150th anniversary of the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences. The event was held on November 1st at 10:30 am in the Galen Hall of TELEC.

During the celebrations of the 45th anniversary of the Medical University - Pleven, significant scientific events from the academic calendar of the university were held: XVII National Scientific Conference for Students and Teachers, organized by the Medical College at the Medical University - Pleven; XVII International Conference for Students and Young Doctors under the motto "Awaken your dreams"; 22nd scientific and practical conference on dermatology and venereology dermatology as well as an celebratory scientific conference, organized together with the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences (BAS).

The Celebratory Scientific Conference, held on November 1 and 2, was attended by over 320 specialists from all medical schools in the country as well as from the institutes of BAS and international guests from Germany, Poland and Russia. The conference was opened on November 1 - Day of Enlightenment, with plenary lectures by two prominent scientists and holders of the honorary title "Doctor Honoris Causa" of the Medical University - Pleven.

228 reports and electronic posters were presented in the twelve scientific sections: "Obstetrics and Gynecology", "Biomedicine and Nanotechnology", "Internal Medicine", "Health Care Management; Nursing and Obstetrics", "Social Medicine and Medical Ethics", "Surgery and Orthopedics", "Pediatrics and Medical Genetics", "Pharmacy", "Medical and Biological Sciences", "Microbiology, Infectious Diseases, Epidemiology and Parasitology", "Other Clinical Sciences" and "Miscellaneous". The results of the research disclosed at the scientific forum provoked interesting discussions and future plans for joint research projects.

MU-PLEVEN WON AN AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTION TO PERSONALIZED MEDICINE IN BULGARIA

Medical University - Pleven was represented by Prof. Dr. Savelina Popovska, Vice-Rector and Head of the Department of Clinical Pathology, during the Second Balkan Conference on Personalized Medicine in the period 24-25 October 2019 in Sofia.

The forum was organized by the Bulgarian Alliance for Precise and Personalized Medicine (BAPPM) in cooperation with the European Alliance for Personalized Medicine (EAPM), Medical University - Pleven and the Bulgarian Scientific Society of Human Genomics and Genetics. The Balkan Conference was intended as a forum for sharing good practices in personalized medicine and discussing opportunities for partnership and regional cooperation between the countries of the Balkan region, which will serve as a model for other European countries. The experts focused on finding optimal ways of integrating personalized medicine into the health systems of the different states of the European Union. They discussed the possibilities for accelerating the introduction of innovative drugs and diagnostic tools in clinical practice, building the necessary legal and regulatory framework and improving patients' access to innovative treatment. During the forum, the foundations of the Balkan Network for Personalized Medicine were laid.

The opening day of the Second Balkan Conference was attended by

representatives from Slovenia, Cyprus, Croatia, the United States, Poland, Luxembourg, the European Commission and the Finnish Presidency of the European Council. The two days of the forum were attended by many prominent lecturers who presented the different perspectives of all interested parties, their expertise and their latest ideas on how general medical community can and should move forward in this inspiring new world of personalized, targeted medicine.

The plenary sessions of the conference were dedicated to the topics of genomics, pathology of personalized medicine and personalized medicine in oncology, neurology, psychiatry and rare diseases.

A NEW VR EDUCATIONAL LABORATORY HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED AT MU-PLEVEN AS PART OF THE COMPETENCE CENTER

On November 18th, 2019, over 30 Bulgarian and international medical students from IV and V year participated in the first exclusive demonstration of 360-degree observation of surgical manipulation above the OR in virtual reality (VR) with the help of VR glasses. The Minimally invasive surgery demonstration was hosted by Prof. Dr. Slavcho Tomov, MD. This happened during the Open Days in the specially equipped Studio for learning in a virtual reality environment VR OR 360° at the Faculty of Pharmacy. The event involved the participation of the project team, tasked to build a Center of Competence in Personalized Medicine, 3D and Telemedicine, robotic and minimally invasive surgery.

Medical University - Pleven and the Faculty of Pharmacy, fully equipped and opened a Laboratory for training surgeons in virtual reality /VR/ under a European project to build a Center of Competence in personalized medicine, 3D and telemedicine, robotic and minimally invasive surgery, funded by the Operational Program Science and Education for Smart Growth. The aim of the specially equipped VR studio is to establish a thorough process for research and training of surgeons, young doctors and students through 360-degree observation of surgical manipulations in virtual reality /VR/ using VR glasses. The high-tech studio can observe real-time operations and manipulations as well as pre-recorded ones. A catalog of recorded operations and manipulations is created, in which additional information such as patient, diagnosis and other medical and scientific data is added. The VR studio for training surgeons, young doctors and students will improve their receptivity, detail-oriented thinking and knowledge in the field of minimally invasive and robotic surgery, without the need to be on site in the operating room.

In the Shumen Branch of the Medical University - Varna a student competition called "Learning to help" was held for the very first time. The event was organized in two parts: theoretical training and practical skills, and was held on November 14th and 15th. PROFESSOR DR. KRASIMIR IVANOV PERFORMED THE FIRST SURGICAL INTERVENTION WITH A DA VINCI XI SYSTEM IN VARNA

The Medical University in cooperation with University Hospital "St. Marina" initiated the project for robotic surgery in Varna. The first robot-assisted surgical intervention in the sea capital of Bulgaria was performed by Prof. Dr. Krassimir Ivanov. The latest, fourth generation Da Vinci Xi model was installed in the university hospital in Varna, which allows well-trained surgeons to perform all types of abdominal and thoracic surgery as well as interventions in both urology and gynecology cases.

MU - Varna and University Hospital "St. Marina" are preparing 4 surgical teams to be able to perform the full range of surgical interventions in the field of abdominal surgery and urology. The system is equipped with built-in simulators through which young surgeons will train and acquire the necessary skills.

The teams, led by the Rector of MU - Varna, Prof. Dr. Krassimir Ivanov, have been trained in leading European clinics and have the ambition to become



a training center for highly qualified specialists in robotic surgery.

generation of magnetic resonance guarantees the production of high-quality images in whole-body examinations, specialized examinations of the brain and spinal cord, musculoskeletal system, abdominal organs, etc.

The highly qualified team of specialists in imaging diagnostics have already undergone an intensive training course on the already installed and functional MRI machine at the Medical Center "St. Marina" - Pleven. The team consists of: Dr. Dimitar Angelov, Dr. Tihomir Stoyanov, X-ray technician Vanya Valova and specialist Mirela Vasileva.

This modern, current-gen imaging technology boasts many advantages as compared to its previous-gen counterparts, among which are: increased patient comfort due to extended space and a relatively silent operation mode; extreme imaging clarity due to the Tim 4G technology; Dot (Day optimising throughput) technology and its more contemporary DotGo counterpart to increase the ease of use of all protocols and improve the accuracy and readability of every investigation; 50% reduced duration of investigations, improving patient comfort and general turnaround time.

THE EYE CLINIC AT THE HOSPITAL "DR. G. STRANSKI" - PLEVEN ACQUIRED A UNIQUE SUPERMODERN DEVICE

The Eye Clinic at the University Hospital "Dr. G. Stranski" in Pleven acquired a unique state-of-the-art device for the latest generation bloodless surgery. A team, headed by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Snezhana Murgova, MD will operate the device. The acquisition was funded directly by the hospital. With the new equipment, the team will be able to help all patients suffering from cataracts, bleeding in the eye, diseases of the macula or who need removal of a foreign body from the eye. CONSTELLATION® Vision System is a combined microsurgical system used in ophthalmic surgery for anterior and posterior segment surgery. CONSTELLATION contains three devices - a module for anterior segment surgery with 3 different types of unique tips, a module for posterior segment surgery with a further developed 3-D technology for work in the posterior segment and a new generation retinal laser with voice confirmation of selected settings. The front segment module with a unique OziL tip has the ability to combine the use of longitudinal and rotational movement of the tip, and is so far unparalleled in clinical practice around the world. This feature of the device allows the surgeon to perform surgery faster, safer and less traumatizing for patients with cataracts. The rear
